


City Revenue & Expenses in Cuyahoga and Lorain Counties

This report is a comparative analysis of 2018 revenue and expenses for 46 cities in Cuyahoga and Lorain counties. The analysis is based on city audit data reported to the Ohio Auditor and compiled in the standardized Hinkel reports. A data viz on the next page allows readers to select groups of cities for analysis. Looking at data from several cities allows one to see important differences and provides better context for data evaluation. Revenue and expense data are presented as totals and on a per capita basis so that cities can be more easily compared. Data for specific revenue and expense categories and additional pertinent financial data are presented. Finally, the auditor's Financial Health Indicators are presented to show how much financial stress the city is experiencing.









Total Revenue for Cleveland & West Shore Cities


Per Capita Revenue for Cleveland & West Shore Cities










Comparing Per Capita Income Tax Revenue Among Cleveland & West Shore Cities



Comparing Other Revenue Sources of Cleveland & West Shore Cities









Comparing Per Capita Police, Fire & Security Expense for Cleveland & West Shore Cities




Comparing Per Capita Other Expenses for Cleveland & West Shore Cities

Cities With Below Average P/C Total Expenses Pay Less for Police/Fire/Security & for Other Current Expenses







Police, Fire & Security don't appear to account fully for Above Average P/C Total Expenses




Boxplots Offer a Way to Look for Outliers Among Selected Cities




Comparing Per Capita Capital Outlay, Debt Service & Other Expenses for Cleveland & West Shore Cities



Comparing Per Capita Total Expenditures & Surplus/Deficit for Cleveland & West Shore Cities




Comparing Per Capita Pension Liabilities for Cleveland & West Shore Cities






